**STANDING ORDER REGARDING EXPIRATION OF ALL PERMANENT PROCESS SERVER
ORDERS IN THE STATE COURT OF FULTON COUNTY AND IMPLEMENTING NEW
PROCEDURES FOR PRIVATE PROCESS SERVERS**

Any and all permanent process server orders from the State Court of Fulton County will expire December 31, 2011. Any person who seeks to be appointed as a permanent process server in the State Court of Fulton County must apply for a new appointment order. The new application and instructions are available on line at georgiacourts.org/courts/fulton. Each new appointment order will authorize private process servers to serve law suits and other legal actions in the State Court of Fulton County and be effective on and after January 1, 2012. All new appointment orders effective on or after January 1, 2012 will expire December 31, 2013, regardless of when applied for and granted. Persons seeking to be appointed process server for the remainder of 2011 shall fill out the new application and, if approved, their appointment order shall only be valid until December 31, 2011. Persons wishing to continue to serve suits in the State Court of Fulton County on or after December 31, 2013 must re-apply for a new appointment order. Permanent Process Server Orders will have the following cycle:

Appointment Orders with Case Numbers of "12 PS" are valid from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013; applications for appointment orders valid for 2014 and 2015 may be filed with the Court on or after July 1, 2013.

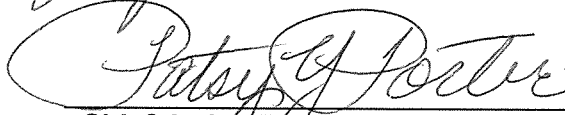
Appointment Orders with Case Numbers of "14 PS" are valid from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015; applications for appointment orders valid for 2016 and 2017 may be filed with the Court on or after July 1, 2015.

Appointment Orders with Case Numbers of "16 PS" are valid from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017; applications for appointment orders valid for 2018 and 2019 may be filed with the Court on or after July 1, 2017.

Appointment Orders with Case Numbers of "18 PS" are valid from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019;

applications for appointment orders valid for 2020 and 2021 may be filed with the Court on or after July 1, 2019.
